DRESS CONSERVATIVELY

Law firms may have five-day business casual, but the 'uniform' is expected for all interviews. Keep the colours plain, wear minimal/subtle make-up & jewellery

HAVE A GAME PLAN

Legal interviews usually take a conversational, non-directed approach. Find ways to show the firm that you have what they're looking for - do your research! First impressions are lasting impressions!

ADDRESS WEAKNESSES POSITIVELY

As the legal job market is extremely competitive, you need to address your weaknesses positively! Be ready to tactfully and gracefully overcome those objections in an interview

DON'TS

BE LATE - EVER

Arrive for your interview at least 15 minutes before. This gives off a strong impression. In a law firm, everything revolves around billable deadlines. Arriving early shows time keeping to be a strength

CRITICISE OTHERS

Never bad-mouth your former employer. Doing so will make your interviewer wonder what you'll say about them if you're hired. It is very unprofessional & poor etiquette

FORGET TO THANK YOUR INTERVIEWERS

Send a short thank-you note via email within 24 hours of your interview. This is basic interview etiquette and will keep you in the forefront of their minds
